- (4) Method of Secondary Offering The offering will be a secondary offering. All the selling shares shall be purchased for sale by the underwriting syndicate (the “Underwriters”) led by an underwriter designated as the lead manager.
As commission to the underwriters, the aggregate amount of the difference between the selling price and the underwriting price (at which the selling shareholders shall be paid as a purchase price per share by the underwriters) shall be paid.

- (6) The selling price and any other matters necessary for the Secondary Offering by way of Over-allotment will be determined at the discretion of Kazunari Ogawa, Representative Director, President & CEO of the Company.
- (7) If the Secondary Offering by way of Purchase and Underwriting by the underwriters is cancelled, the Secondary Offering by way of Over-allotment shall also be cancelled.

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
